POLICY STATEMENT

Boom Sherrin is committed to providing and maintaining a safe working environment for all employees and visitors. The company's goal is to be a zero harm organisation. There is no compromise for safety at Boom Sherrin. Creating, maintaining and driving an excellent standard of safety is a condition of employment for all Boom Sherrin employees and management staff.

This commitment extends to ensuring that Boom Sherrin's operations do not place the public, the community or the environment at risk of injury, illness or damage.

Boom Sherrin will;

- Provide safe plant and systems of work.
- Provide written procedures and instructions for safe systems of work.
- Ensure compliance with legislative requirements and standards for health and safety.
- Provide instructions, training and supervision for employees and customers for their health and safety.
- Provide support and assistance to employees.
- Risk assess the work place to identify and control hazards to employees, visitors and customers' health and safety.
- Strive to become a zero harm organisation and ensure employees leave work in the same condition in which they arrived.
- Review injury and incident statistics to identify trends and hazards in order to develop preventative and corrective actions.
- Aim to reduce the amount of lost time injuries by 30% on the previous year results.

We will aim to continually improve the standard of health and safety at Boom Sherrin and create a strong safety culture. This is achieved through the risk management process which incorporates consultation with employees.

Our duty of care requires that all employees are subject to compulsory pre employment checks and relevant employees are subjected to ongoing medical checks.
